Volunteer Opportunities

In order to maintain our very reasonable fee structure, yet provide the Players with a top-level hockey experience, the Central Hockey Club is a volunteer-run organization. As such, it is very important that support for many of the off-ice activities is shared by the organization.

Some of the activities that provide an opportunity for your involvement include:

Team Pictures

Arrange for a date for the pictures to be taken early in the season (preferably after October 15th) and coordinate details with the photographer.

Senior Night

Set a date for the Senior Night celebration to take place before one of the final home games, preferably on a Saturday evening. Coordinate with the Board and other volunteers for the festivities to celebrate our Senior Players for the 2008-2009 season.

Burlington Days Parade and Stand

Coordinate with the Board and Coaches for the activities related to participation in the annual Burlington Days parade and the Central Hockey Club stand in the Park following the parade. (Sunday, September 7, 2008)

High School Liaison(s)

Work with the Board to foster and maintain a positive working relationship with the high school administrators to encourage student and faculty attendance at games, notification to the student body of upcoming events and significant accomplishments and generally grow the relationship between the Club and the schools involved.

Assistant Statistician

Assist with the recording of game statistics not kept on the official scoresheet: shots (and shooter), plus/minus and Special Teams percentages.

Timekeeper/Official Scorer

Assist with running the clock and/or keeping the scoresheet when the "Head Scorekeeper" (Kent Petschow) and his assistant (Russ Plum) are not available.

Ticket Manager

At the Varsity level, the team is required to charge admission. Coordinate activities related to staffing a ticket table prior to the game and during the first period (all home games).

End of the Year Celebration and Banquet

Set a date for the festivities (usually in April) and coordinate with the Board, Coaches, Parents and Players for the event. Determine location and work with the restaurant and catering staff. Assist with the agenda and the activities/personnel required to support it. Manage decorations, awards required and collection of money to fund the event.

Sponsorship Chairperson

Coordinate the activities of the entire organization to sell and support our Sponsor community.

Homecoming Parade

Determine the opportunities for participation in the three homecoming parades and coordinate the activities related with the Players, Coaches and other volunteers.
